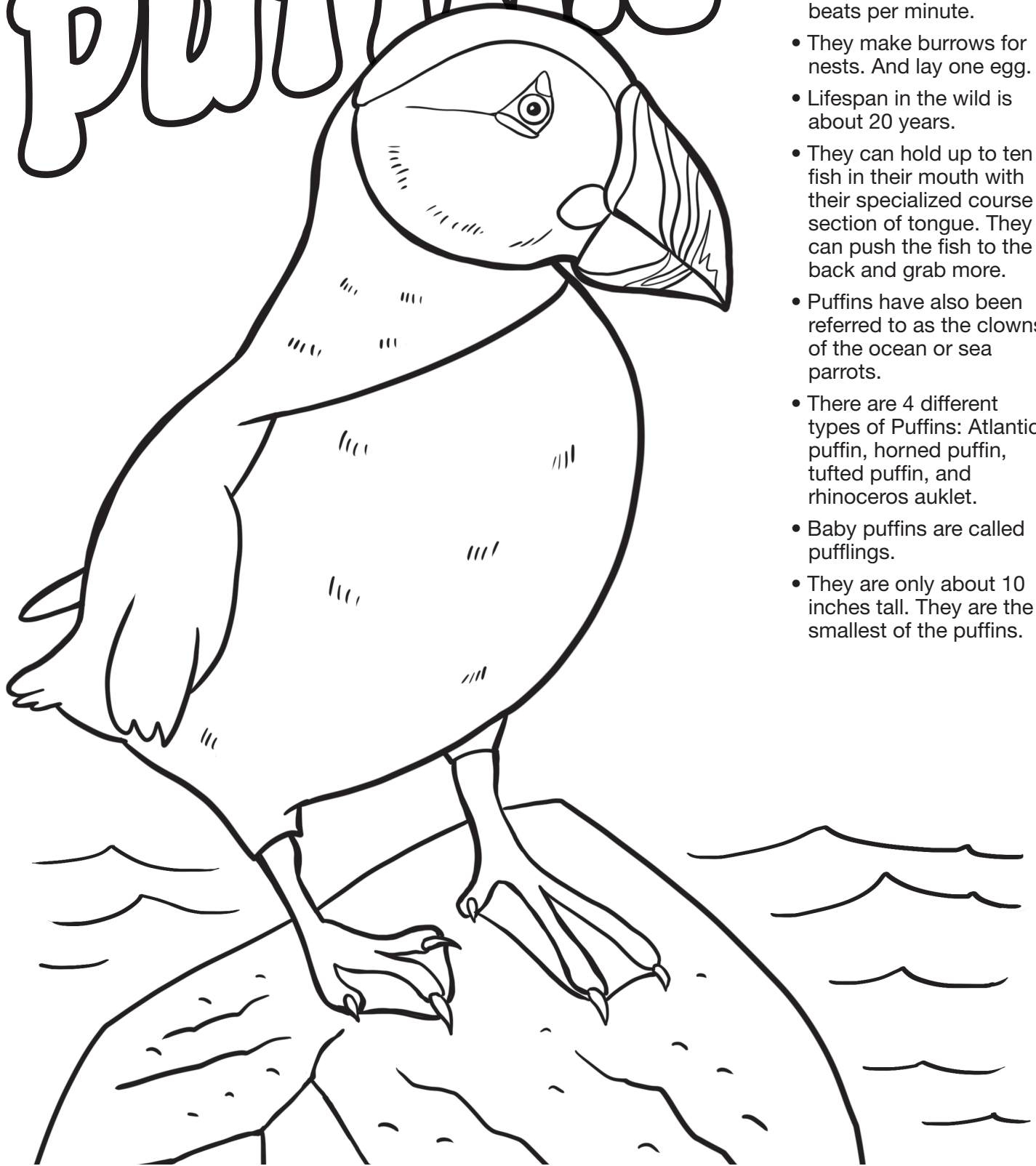


Atlantic Puffins



Facts

- They can fly! Flapping their wings at up to 400 beats per minute.
- They make burrows for nests. And lay one egg.
- Lifespan in the wild is about 20 years.
- They can hold up to ten fish in their mouth with their specialized curve section of tongue. They can push the fish to the back and grab more.
- Puffins have also been referred to as the clowns of the ocean or sea parrots.
- There are 4 different types of Puffins: Atlantic puffin, horned puffin, tufted puffin, and rhinoceros auklet.
- Baby puffins are called pufflings.
- They are only about 10 inches tall. They are the smallest of the puffins.
